CINEMA

- A film, also called a movie, motion picture, theatrical film or photoplay, is a series of still images which, when shown on a screen, creates the illusion of moving images due to the phi phenomenon.
- The word "cinema", short for cinematography, is often used to refer the industry of films and filmmaking or to the art of filmmaking itself.
- The name "film" originates from the fact that photographic film has historically been the medium for recording and displaying motion pictures.

THE HISTORY OF FILM

- Preceding film in origin by thousands of years, early place and dances had elements common to film : scripts, sets, costumes, production, direction, actors, audiences, storyboards and scores.
- The use of sequences of photographs in such devices was initially limited to a few experiments with subjects photographed in a series of poses, because the available emulsions were not sensitive enough to allow the short exposures needed to photograph subjects that were actually moving

HISTORY OF HOLLYWOOD

- Is a neighborhood in the central region of Los Angeles, California. The neighborhood is notable for its place as the home of the United States film industry, including several of its historic studios.
- Its name has come to be a metonym for the motion picture industry of the Unites States. Hollywood is also a highly ethnically diverse, densely populated, economically diverse neighborhood and retail business district.
- Hollywood was a small community in 1870 and was incorporated as a municipality in 1903. It officially merged with the city of Los Angeles in 1910, and soon thereafter a prominent film industry began to emerge, eventually becoming the most recognizable film industry in the world.

 In 1910, the city voted for merge with Los Angeles in order to secure and adequate water supply and to gain access to the Los Angeles sewer system. With annexation, the name of Prospect Avenue changed to Hollywood Boulevard and all the street numbers were also changed.
